

Napolitan Institute Survey of 500 Elites May 1-6, 2024

1* Generally speaking, have colleges been too lenient in dealing with the protesters or have they dealt with the protesters too harshly?

- 23% Much too lenient
- 31% Somewhat too lenient
- 15% Somewhat too harsh
- 10% Much too harsh
- 16% About right
- 6% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 500 Elite Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on May 1-6, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc.

Elites were defined as having a postgraduate degree, having a household income of more than \$150,000 annually, and living in a zip code with more than 10,000 people per square mile. Approximately 1% of the total U.S. population meets these criteria.

Seventy-eight percent (71%) of voters in this sample were Democrats and 23% were Republicans (in both cases, these totals include leaners.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 4.4 percentage points.
