1* To fight inequality, is it more important to increase taxes on the rich or to provide more opportunities for lower income Americans?

34% Increase taxes on rich people

56% Provide more opportunities for lower income Americans

10% Not sure

2* Is it possible for just about anyone who is willing to work to get out of poverty and move into the middle class?

56% Yes

29% No

15% Not sure

3* If someone creates a new, valuable product that lots of people want to use, is it fair for that person to get fabulously rich?

73% Yes

15% No

12% Not sure

Methodology

This Counterpolling™ survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 12, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
