

Napolitan News Service Survey of 1,000 Registered Voters and 500 Elites Conducted March 2024

1* [Among all voters] Would it be better or worse for America if only people with a college degree were allowed to vote?

- 5% Much better
- 10% Somewhat better
- 13% Somewhat worse
- 49% Much worse
- 16% Not much different
- 8% Not sure

* [Among the Elite 1%] Would it be better or worse for America if only people with a college degree were allowed to vote?

- 28% Much better
- 23% Somewhat better
- 14% Somewhat worse
- 24% Much worse
- 7% Not much different
- 4% Not sure

Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 6-7, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The survey of 500 Elites was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on March 6-12, 2024.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
