

## Napolitan News Service Survey of 1,000 Registered Voters Conducted September 30, 2024

1\* Suppose that millions of illegal immigrants were deported and forced to leave the United States. Would that be good news or bad news for working class and lower income Americans?

- 34% Very good news
- 29% Somewhat good news
- 13% Somewhat bad news
- 11% Very bad news
- 13% Not sure

2\* Suppose new policies are implemented that effectively secure the Southern Border. Would you prefer securing the border and allowing all who have already entered illegally to stay? Or, would you prefer both securing the border and deporting a significant number of people who have already entered the country illegally?

- 31% Securing the border and allowing all who have already entered illegally to stay
- 56% Securing the border and deporting a significant number of people who have already entered the country illegally
- 13% Not sure

## Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on September 30, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
