1\* How serious a problem is gun violence in America today?

- 54% Very serious
- 31% Somewhat serious
- 10% Not very serious
- 3% Not at all serious
- 2% Not sure

2\* Which leads to more gun deaths each year? Gang violence or school shootings?

- 54% Gang violence
- 35% School shootings
- 11% Not sure

3\* Would background checks for all gun purchases significantly reduce gun violence and mass shootings?

52% Yes29% No18% Not sure

4\* Is the following statement true or false: Background checks are already conducted for the vast majority of gun sales.

- 58% True
- 25% False
- 18% Not sure

## Methodology

This survey of 1,000 Registered Voters was conducted online by Scott Rasmussen on October 14-15, 2024. Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc. Certain quotas were applied, and the sample was lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet usage, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population of Registered Voters. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.

The margin of sampling error for the full sample is +/- 3.1 percentage points.
